

ArtsVote in Ohio

(Updated as of 6/20/24)



Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2024

CONFIRM: Pre-Requisites

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be at least 18 years old on or before the day of the general election
- Be a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days immediately before the election
- Not incarcerated for a felony conviction under the laws of this state, another state, or the United States
- Not been declared incompetent for voting purposes by a probate court
- Not been permanently disenfranchised for violating the election laws

STEP 1: Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your <u>current voter registration</u> or Register to Vote for the first time <u>online</u>, <u>in-person</u>, or <u>by mail</u>. Voter registration forms must be either RECEIVED by your <u>county board of elections</u> or SUBMITTED online by Monday, October 7, 2024. *Don't delay, pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by Monday, September 23, 2024.*

STEP 2: Request Your Absentee Ballot (If Preferred)

In Ohio, <u>voting by absentee</u> ballot **does not require an excuse**, but you must <u>apply for it</u> because it will not be sent to you automatically. There are 2 ways to request your absentee ballot: 1) Print your request form and <u>mail it to your county board of elections</u> or, 2) Call and request an application be mailed to you by your <u>county board of elections</u>. You can begin requesting an absentee ballot application on January 1, 2024 or 90 Days before the Election (Monday August 5, 2024) and the completed application must be RECEIVED by **Noon on Tuesday, October 29, 2024**. *If you prefer to vote by absentee ballot, pledge to submit your absentee ballot application by Tuesday, October 15, 2024*.

STEP 3: Cast Your Vote

ABSENTEE BALLOTS: In Ohio, completed mail-in absentee ballots must be POSTMARKED to the **county board of elections** by **Monday, November 4, 2024** in order to be counted. Alternatively, you can HAND-DELIVER your absentee ballot in-person to your **county board of elections** on **Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024** at **7:30pm**. You can sign up to **track your absentee ballot** on the Ohio Board of Elections website. **Don't delay, pledge to mail-in your completed absentee ballot by Monday, Oct. 21, 2024**.

- OR -

IN-PERSON VOTING: You may vote early in Ohio at specific <u>Early Voting sites</u> beginning as early as <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October 8</u>, <u>2024</u> through <u>Sunday</u>, <u>November 3</u>, <u>2024</u> (times vary, check your <u>local county board of elections</u>). If <u>voting on Election Day</u>, polls will be open from <u>6:30am</u> to <u>7:30pm</u>. You can find your <u>polling location</u> on the Ohio Board of Elections website. Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. <u>Don't delay</u>, <u>pledge to cast your vote during Early Voting and avoid the crowds</u>.

STEP 4: Celebrate Your Vote
